

For Nook Color, Tablet, HD & HD+

Instructions for Borrowing Nook E-books from My Media Mall with App

* You can now download e-books through an app for My Media Mall. This is the easiest way to read borrowed e-books on the Nook Color, Tablet, and HD devices.

* Using the OverDrive Media Console App is the only way that you can wirelessly download books to your Nook devices.

* EPUB formats (not PDF formats) work best on the Nook device.

1. Downloading the App and Authorizing Your Device

- Go to the **Nook App Store** and find the **OverDrive Media Console App**, which is available for free. Install and open the app.



- Click the **Menu** button and select **App Settings**. Choose **Authorize with Adobe ID**.

- Click **Get a free Adobe ID** and follow the instructions. Once you have an ID created, go back to the app and enter your ID and password
- Click the **Menu** button and then click **Get Books**.
- Click **Add a Library**. Our library is under the name **Illinois Heartland Library System**. You may have to log in with your barcode that starts with 23034 and PIN number (which is the last four digits of your phone number).
- Click the star to save your library (after you click it, the star will turn yellow). Click on **My Media Mall** to open **My Media Mall**.

2. Browsing for E-books

- To **Browse** for e-books, click on the **Magnifying Glass** icon to search for a title, author, or subject.



- Click on the **Menu** icon to browse by type or genre of book.



- Click on the **Magnifying Glass** icon again, and then click **Advanced Search** (right side, under the Go button) to browse for EPUB formats.
- To search for books that you can checkout right away, click the **Magnifying Glass** icon, and then tap **Advanced Search** (right side, under the Go button). Choose EPUB format and then check **Available Now**. Then click **Search**.

3. Checking out an E-book or Placing a Hold

- To check out an e-book, click **Borrow** and then **Go to Bookshelf**.
- From your My Media Mall **Bookshelf**, select your desired format (the EPUB eBook) and then select **Confirm**.

- You can check out up to 5 items at a time.
- If the item is not available, you can choose to put a hold on it. Click the **Place a Hold** button, and enter your e-mail address. You will be notified when the item is available to be downloaded.

- When the hold comes in, you will receive an e-mail message. Open your **OverDrive Media Console App** on your Nook and **Sign In**.
- Click on the **Account** icon, and then click the **Holds** icon. The hold will now have the **Borrow** button next to it. The steps to check out the book are the same as above.

4. Downloading the EPUB book to your Device

- Click the **Download** button after you have **Confirmed** that you want the book. The title will download and open in the app's **Bookshelf**.
- Click the **Menu** button and choose **Bookshelf**. Click the e-book to open it.
- For the EPUB books, tap or swipe the screen to turn pages. Click the center of the page to bring up various setting options or tap the **Menu** button and choose **Reader Settings** to select viewing options.

5. Deleting or Returning E-books

- Downloads are automatically returned at the end of the loan period, which means you will never have an overdue e-book. You can also choose to return them early and check out more books.
- The e-books will not work after the loan period (7 or 14 days) ends. There are no renewals allowed for e-books unfortunately. However, you can borrow the same item again if it is available to be checked out.
- You must manually delete expired e-books to save space. They will not disappear automatically after the loan period ends.
- To delete or return EPUB e-books early, you have to go to the **OverDrive Media Console App**.
 - Click on **Bookshelf**.
 - Click the plus sign on the right-side of the title. Then, choose **Return/Delete**.

6. Help

- For finding help through My Media Mall, open the **OverDrive Media Console App**, and click the **Menu** button. Click **Bookshelf**, then **More Options**, and then choose **Help**.
